This gives us the opportunity to visit other points of interest around the areas on the tour. Or if we have any unfavourable weather conditions, bike hassles or flatties, or you just simply need to rest the legs for a little bit, then we can accommodate accordingly. Day 1: Christchurch – Fairlie

- We drive 1½ hours south from Christchurch to Geraldine to resume the Sounds to Sounds journey, starting with a good warm up ride through classic rolling farmland.
- In the evening, we enjoy a meal at a local restaurant, reconnecting with fellow travellers or getting to know new ones.

CYCLE DISTANCE: 1 DAY: 53KM TOTAL CLIMB: 794M

Days 2 - 4: Fairlie - Omarama

- Day 2 is a scenic ride over McKenzie Pass into the stunning Mackenzie Country, through the alpine village of Tekapo and onto lake Pukaki to stay on a high country station.
- Day 3 we ride the Alps 2 Ocean Trail following the turquoise canals and open landscapes of the Mackenzie Basin, breathtaking views of Aoraki Mt Cook and the Southern Alps guide us along lake Pukaki. We continue alongside the lake and canals to Lake Oahau, finishing at a lodge near the lake's edge.
- Day 4, we begin with a rewarding 11km climb to Tarnbrae Saddle — the highest point of the A2O — followed by a long scenic descent through the Quailburn Valley into Omarama, where we spend the night. Optional soak in the Omarama Hot Tubs.

CYCLE DISTANCE: 3 DAYS: 203KM TOTAL CLIMB: 2028M

Day 5 - 7: Omarama - Cromwell

- Day 5, the toughest day of the tour! We ride over Omarama Saddle with a 700m climb to a 1250m summit. Expect creek crossings, wide-open views, and possibly some hike-a-bike. The day ends at a favourite lodge in Wedderburn.
- Day 6, enjoy a relaxed ride along the Otago Rail Trail to the rural town of Alexandra.
- Day 7, we tackle the spectacular Lake Dunstan Trail — cliff-hugging paths and bolt-on bridges offer stunning views before arriving in Cromwell for the night.

CYCLE DISTANCE: 3 DAYS: 211KM TOTAL CLIMB: 2154M

Day 8 - 10 : Cromwell - Te Anau

- Day 8, a challenging ascent up the Nevis Road to the highest point of the tour (1273m), followed by a descent and final push over the Nevis Saddle into Garston.
- Day 9, we join the Around the Mountains Trail and ride to Mossburn, surrounded by classic Southland farmland and big skies.
- Day 10, a mostly downhill cruise takes us to Te Anau. If time allows, we may ride a few kilometres toward Milford Sound to shorten the final day's ride.

CYCLE DISTANCE: 3 DAYS: 231KM TOTAL CLIMB: 2705M

Day 11- 12 : Te Anau - Christchurch

- Day 11, the final and longest ride of the tour! Mostly on sealed road, we climb to the Homer Tunnel before an exhilarating descent into the majestic Milford Sound. Celebrate the completion of the full Sounds to Sounds journey — 1490km ridden and over 16,000m climbed — with a toast before returning to Te Anau for our final night together.
- Day 12, the PureTrails bus departs Te Anau, returning to Christchurch or continuing to your next destination.

CYCLE DISTANCE: 1 DAY: 118KM TOTAL CLIMB: 1873M
